

Family Engagement Workshops

This **intergenerational program** brings together students and their parents/ caregivers, and strengthens community bonds. Schools/community centers can choose from a variety of social dances, such as **Latin dances, Afrobeat, West African dances, Step, and Hip Hop**. These workshops can be stand-alone events from 60 minutes to 2 hours long, or a series of workshops. They are offered at times when parents/caregivers are able to join their children. Siblings and other family members are also welcome.



For largely Hispanic communities, a **bilingual artist** leads the workshops. Latin dance workshops focus on various styles, including **cumbia, salsa, merengue, bachata** and more. Students also learn partnering skills. In all styles, the steps are broken down and the teaching artist ensures that movements are accessible to a wide variety of ages and abilities.

Family engagement workshops enhance a sense of community, strengthen familial and peer-to-peer bonds, improve physical, social and emotional health, expand opportunities for participants to meet, give recently immigrated families a feeling of home, and create an inclusive and fun experience for all.
